While attending the APTA Rail Conference in Chicago, come out and enjoy a “relaxing” 18 holes of golf. Take time to visit the Product Showcase during the conference to support our business members as you also support our future transportation leaders at this golf tournament.

Harborside International Golf Center is a links style layout, championship golf course designed by Dick Nugent in the links tradition of treeless, wind swept English, Scottish, and Irish seaside courses, which carry golfers back to where the game began. During the PGA's most recent tour stop here, Ben Crenshaw compared Harborside to Muirfield in Scotland, which has been the sight of several British Opens, including the 2001 championship won by Ernie Els.

The course offers stunning views of the city skyline and the Port of Chicago amid 458 isolated acres of sculpted fairways, manicured greens, tufted mounds and tangled roughs. It also has a top-rated 57-acre practice facility with grass tee driving range, as well as chipping and pitching greens, roughs and bunkers. And, it's just 16 minutes from downtown Chicago, located along I-94.

APTF will have its awards ceremony immediately following the tournament in the magnificent, 24,000 square-foot Prairie Style club house with appetizers provided by the clubhouse's provider, Chicago's top restaurateur, Phil Stefani.

Finding Harborside

From the North, Northwest and some West communities

Take the Dan Ryan south to the Bishop Ford Expressway. Just past 95th Street Exit, the Ryan splits. Bishop Ford Expressway signs say I-94 "To Indiana." Exit at 111th Street (Exit 66A) turn left over the Expressway and left again at the stop sign. Approximately 50 yards down the ramp is a cutoff to the frontage road. Turn right and then right again (South) on the frontage road. Entrance to Harborside is approximately 125 yards on the left.

From the South, Southwest, some West communities and Indiana

Take the Bishop Ford Expressway (I-94) to the 115th Street Exit (Exit 66B). Turn right at the first cutoff, before 115th Street, to the frontage road. Proceed left (North) on the frontage road to the Harborside entrance 500 yards on the right.
